

Dear Friends and Supporters,

As we reflect on 2025, we want to pause and thank God—and you—for an incredible year of ministry at Live Free Ministry. What began as a step of faith turned into a year far beyond what we initially imagined. (Think Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine ...”)

2025 Ministry Impact

At the start of the year, our goal was to come alongside and minister to 25 individuals. Individuals who are broken or struggling with life, typically living on the edges of society. By God’s grace, we finished 2025 having ministered to 56 people—more than double our original goal.

We averaged 2.4 people ministered to each day
We spent an average of 1.6 hours per person
40% of our time was spent meeting in person
50% of our time was spent ministering by phone
10% of our time was dedicated to facilitating groups

Our goal was to lead four groups this year. Instead, we were able to lead six groups, reaching an additional 25 people through group ministry.

New Opportunities God Provided

In addition to exceeding our original goals of our core ministry, God opened doors we did not anticipate:

Prayer Ministry

We launched a dedicated prayer ministry focused on helping individuals find freedom from strongholds that have kept them from living the lives God intended.

Prison Ministry

We began serving in prison ministry—Kevin is currently ministering to two inmates, and Linda to one—bringing hope, prayer, and discipleship into places often forgotten.

Meeting Practical Needs

We supported families facing hardship by providing \$5,000 in gift cards to those struggling with food insecurity. We also supplemented local food pantries with \$500 worth of food during a time of increased demand, especially when government shutdowns impacted many families.

International Outreach – Pakistan

We were also blessed with the opportunity to support a Christian family who is spreading the gospel in Pakistan who operate a Christian school. Christians are a 2% minority in Pakistan and often face severe persecution. Through this partnership, we are helping provide school supplies and daily meals for 25 low-income children.

Our monthly support of \$100 covers five students, and additional donations helped install 2 fresh-water pumps (each pump is only \$250)., providing clean water to communities that previously had travel long distances to carry water for daily needs.



“With deep gratitude and honor, we thank Live Free Ministry for providing another hand pump for the brick-kiln families. Before this blessing, men, women, and children had to walk long distances just to get one bucket of water. Every drop came with exhaustion, lost work hours, and daily struggle. Clean water was a constant worry. Today, because of this hand pump, they have easy access to clean water for drinking, cooking, washing, and hygiene. It has brought health, relief, dignity, and hope to families living under hardship. Looking Ahead to 2026

As we step into 2026, we are prayerfully seeking new opportunities and setting both ministry and financial goals God is placing before us:

Minister to 75 individuals.

Teach and facilitate four- six groups.

Continue expanding the new ministry areas launched in 2025.

Explore involvement with Celebrate Recovery, including providing childcare so families are not prevented from attending Monday night meetings.(Estimated cost: \$50–\$60 per week for 3–4 families).

Expand ministry to include couples counseling (already in progress).

Pursue a chaplain’s license for Kevin to allow for increased in-person prison ministry.

Provide transportation assistance, including short-term and longer-term vehicle support allowing people who don’t have a vehicle to use a vehicle provided by the ministry. (already being utilized).

Offer faith-based recovery support to Waukesha sober-living homes.

Expand ministry reach others throughout the US through Zoom-based opportunities.
